


Figure 11-2. What Does A Title IV-E Permanency Dollar Buy?

a. This category includes amounts claimed (in FY2013) for support of children who were eligible for Title IV-E guardianship assistance in that year because they were receiving assistance, as of September 30, 2008, under an approved Title IV-E subsidized guardianship waiver project.

b. Non-recurring Assistance Payments are amounts paid to adoptive parents or kinship guardians to reimburse (or offset) the cost of finalizing an adoption or establishing a legal guardianship.
